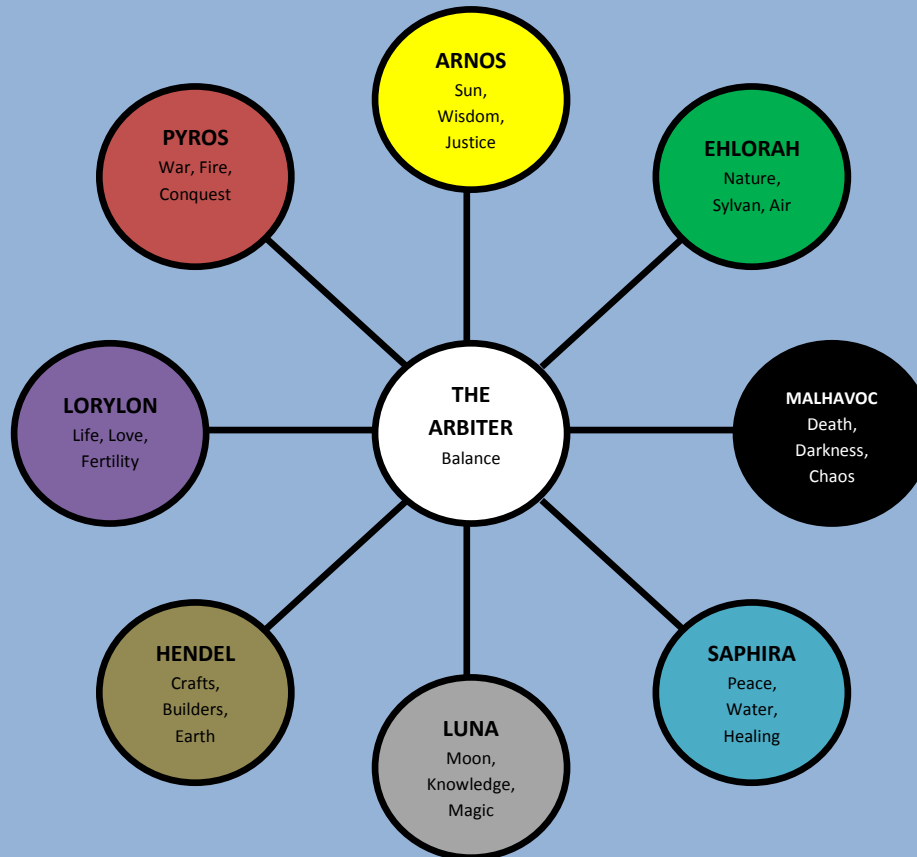


THE CONCORDIAN
